Programs and Services:

Meals on Wheels: For homebound frail older adults who are unable to shop and/or prepare meals for themselves, we deliver three meals a day, five days a week directly to their homes.

Senior Lunch Program: Hot, nutritious lunches are provided at 27 centers to people 60 years and older. Besides maintaining the physical health of older adults, these programs also work to enrich the emotional/psychological health of seniors by providing a wide range of activities.

Adult Day Health Care Centers: Located in Anaheim and Santa Ana are programs designed for individuals with physical and/or mental impairments. The centers provide supportive therapies to enable individuals and their loved ones to maintain as much daily independence as possible. Services include: medical/nursing monitoring, physical and occupational therapy, social services, nutritional services, activities and transportation.

Adult Day Care Center: Located in Buena Park this program offers support and temporary respite to families and friends who are caring for a frail older loved one. This program provides a safe and comfortable daytime environment where seniors can enjoy games, crafts and social interaction with their peers.

Volunteer Program: Volunteer opportunities are available throughout the organization including our Friendly Visitor Program connecting caring volunteers with isolated older adults who benefit from the social interaction.

Case Management: Clients facing multiple problems receive assistance from our case managers to help them evaluate and find acceptable solutions to meet their individual needs.

Homemaking/Personal Care/Respite: Our in-home services arrange for paid caregivers to provide basic personal care and light housekeeping assistance for very low income seniors. Our respite care provides support and relief to caregivers.

Home Safety Program: This program provides home safety inspections and repairs in the homes of the frail elderly. Slight modifications are made that assist in keeping a senior safely in their own home.
